

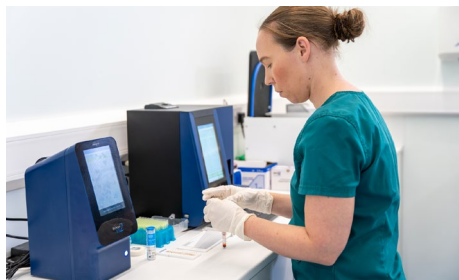
Established in 2000 on the site of an old police station in Waterloo Village, our RCVS tier-two small animal accredited practice is committed to providing the very best veterinary care.

We accept cash and credit/debit card payments (Maestro, Solo, Delta, Mastercard and Visa). Please note that we no longer accept cheques or American Express as a form of payment.

We deal with all major insurance companies, and are able to process direct insurance claims, by prior arrangement.

What is a direct claim?

A direct claim is where the invoice goes directly to the insurance company rather than to you. This may be useful for larger bills or ongoing medical complaints.

When does a direct claim need to be authorised?

A direct claim takes time to authorise, and as such must be requested before a procedure takes place. Although we do our very best, we cannot always permit a direct claim for every patient for every condition.

What information do we need to process a direct claim?

- The name of your insurance company.
- Your policy number and policy excess.
- The inception date (the date policy was taken out).
- The maximum insurable amount per condition (varies between £500 and £12,000).
- Any co-payments (often applicable to older patients, usually 20%).
- Any exclusions (anything the policy no longer covers; these are common in older patients with pre-existing conditions and a time limited policy).

We can obtain this information directly from your insurance company, but you must first give your insurance company permission to speak with us.

Do you need to pay when you collect your pet?

There will be a direct claim agreement fee of £30, as well as an excess to pay, which varies between policies, and occurs every 12 months for ongoing conditions. There may also be a co-payment. Additionally, you will need to sign a form to consent to the direct claim.

What is a direct claim agreement form?

This is a form consenting to a direct claim. It confirms that if the insurance company rejects any part of the claim for any reason, liability for the payment is with you.

Some companies will use a pre-authorisation form, where an estimate is submitted and the insurance company checks whether they will accept liability. Depending on the company, this may take days or weeks to approve.

Please note that there is a £30 administration charge for insurance and direct claims.
